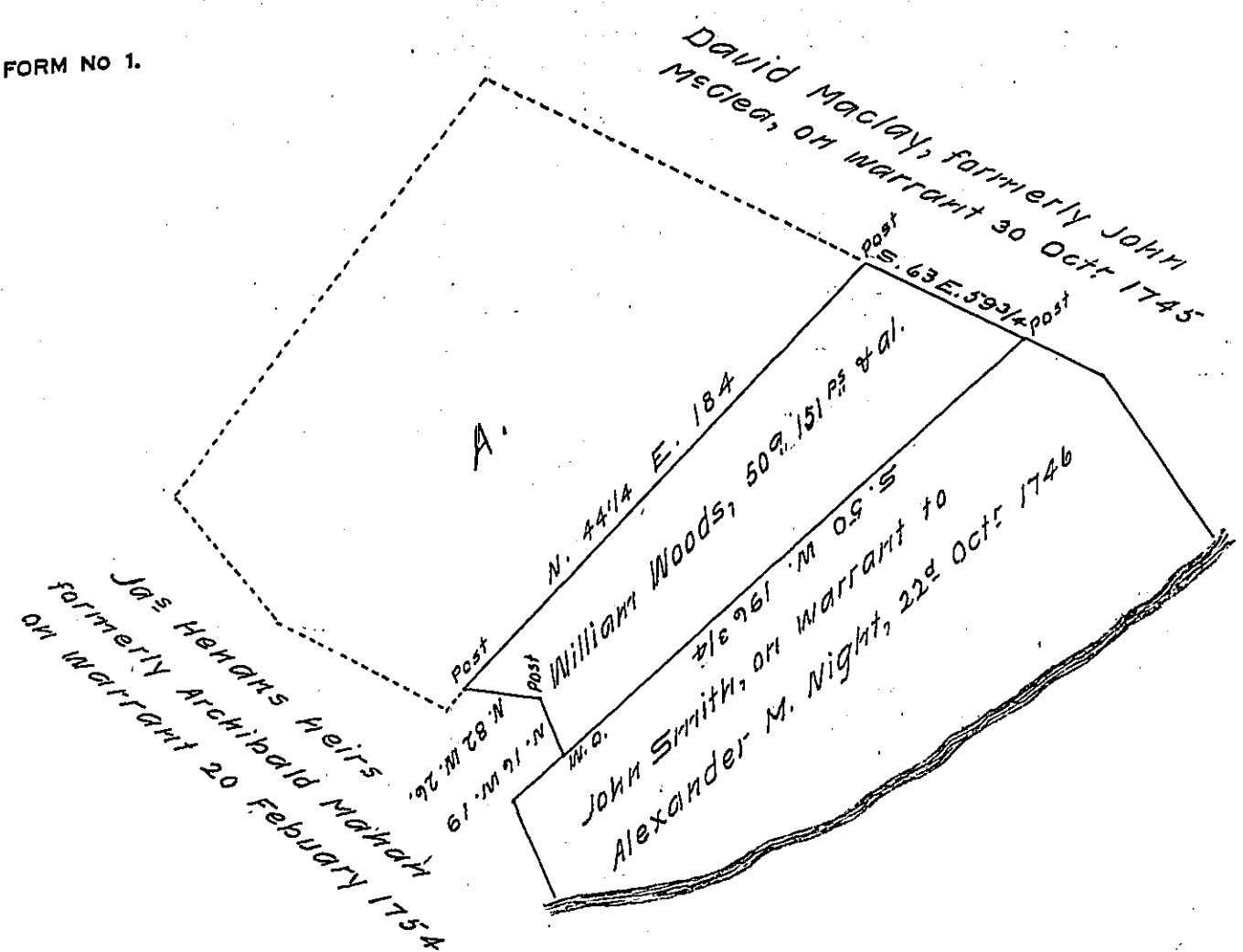


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Lurgan township Franklin county containing fifty acres one hundred & fifty one perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. surveyed 18th september 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of a warrant dated 20 January 1753 granted William Woods, for 50 acres "joining Charles Maclay & Archibald Mahan, in Lurgan township."

Report. The above tract is covered by a survey of 1759 143 E on a warrant dated 22^d December 1786, granted to Robert Tate & held under said title. Note - The dotted figure A. represents the balance of survey on Tate's warrant. No evidence of survey on Wood's warrant, therefore the survey is limited to the quantity of the warrant
