The same interest is included in a larger survey made the 22^d day of October A.D. 1765 for Philip Conrad Au-miller in pursuance of his warrant bearing date the 5th of June 1765 & is now owned & occupied by the heirs of Ande Shaffer, in right of the said P. C. Au-miller, & is represented by the red lines.
