



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 9th day of August 1832 by virtue of a warrant granted to James Armstrong, dated the 3d day of February 1755 containing one hundred and ten acres & eighty perches with the usual allowance of six ft. Ct. &c.

Note. The same being part of a tract of land containing 273.7⁰⁵ and allowance &c. surveyed the 23d day of February 1769 for JOHN HARRIS, in pursuance of a warrant granted to him dated the 17th day of February 1755 and now owned & occupied by Christian Sheekley.
