

granted to James Armstrong dated the 3^d day of February
1755 containing one hundred and ten acres with the usual
allowance.

223.9 a. & allowance &c. Surveyed the 13th August 1769. for
Tho^s Craig, in pursuance of his order dated the 10th day of
August 1767 N. 4279. And now owned & occupied by Robert
Barber, Esq. in right of the said Thomas Craig.
