

of six per cent for roads & so surveyed December
the 20th 1765 in pursuance of a warrant granted to
John Gessma, Jr. dated the 3rd day of June 1762.

N.B. The dotted line represents part of a draft of a tract of
land surveyed for John Gessma, in order No 317 dated the 1st
day of August 1766 this tract interferes one acre and eighty
perches with John Gessma, Jr. John Gessma conveyed to Sa-
muel Maitman, who conveyed to William Boor, the present
owner.
