



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin county containing fifty three acres sixty seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. surveyed the 11th of December 1828 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights & on a warrant granted Samuel Brown, for 50<sup>acs</sup> of land joining his other land James Rankin, & Hugh McKinney, in Peters township dated the 3d of June 1763.

The land above described is included in a survey containing 58<sup>acs</sup> & all which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted James Houston, dated the 18th of March 1788 under which survey the present owner claims there is no evidence of any survey having been made on the warrant of Sam<sup>l</sup> Brown, but it was recognised as Sam<sup>l</sup> Browns by an adjoining survey.
