October 1765- Daniel Africa, D. S.

The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of  
land surveyed for Daniel McFall on order No 2181 dated the 16<sup>th</sup>  
December 1766, this tract interferes two acres and one hundred and  
fourteen perches with the William McClay survey. Daniel Mc-  
Fall conveyed to Samuel Wallace who conveyed to Rhenuban  
Haines who conveyed to David Ralston who conveyed to Adam  
Lightner who abandoned all claim to this part of the Daniel  
McFall tract.
