


FORM NO. 1.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Anttrim township Franklin County containing thirteen acres one hundred and nineteen perches & allowance of six percent for roads & which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted Elias DAIVISON, dated the 16th day of May 1763.

Certified the 12th day of February 1830 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c
