

Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing fifty acres ninety seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1828 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights & on a warrant granted James Campbell, for 50<sup>95</sup>/<sub>100</sub> of land including an improvement purchased of David Rees, joining his other land in Peters township dated the 20<sup>th</sup> of February 1754.

The land above described is included in a survey containing 318<sup>95</sup>/<sub>100</sub> per & all which was surveyed on a warrant granted John Shelby dated the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1772 under which the present owner claims no evidence obtained of any survey having been made on Campbell's warrant but the above \_\_\_\_\_ includes what is supposed to have been David Rees improvement.
