


FORM NO. 1.



Draught of one hundred and seventy five acres and twenty five perches with the allowance, situate in Lack township Mifflin county surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to Richard Goots for 200 acres dated the 15th April 1763

Note - The above survey is covered by a warrant to John Stone dated for 150 acres upon which an order of resurvey was directed by the Board of Property dated 1st April 1793 (date of warrant not known) upon the resurvey a return of 164 a. 95 7/10 was made as represented by the dotted lines in the above plot. It is held by the heirs under the wt to Jno Stone, the dotted lines show the survey as made on Stones, warrant.
