



A draft of a tract of land situate on the north side of the Raystown Jacob Harlan branch of Juniatta about one mile above the mouth of Shawnee Cabin Creek in Napier township Bedford County containing two hundred and thirty six and one half acres and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Robert Ervin, on warrant dated the 20th day of September 1762 - Surveyed the 6th day of December 1765.

No. 1 represented partly by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for James Taylor, the 12th day of March 1813 on warrant dated the 9th day of February 1813. This tract interferes two hundred & thirty six and one half acres with the Robert Ervin tract. James Taylor, bought the Robert Ervin tract for taxes and then obtained the afore said warrant and is the present owner.

No. 2 represented by broken lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Wilson the 20th February 1766 on warrant dated the 20th day of September 1762 this tract interferes one hundred and eleven acres and ninety four perches with the Robert Ervin survey. John Wilson conveyed to John Ormsby who conveyed to Barnard Dougherty whose assignees last same at law. James O'Connor
