


FORM NO 1.

Located in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. and by virtue of a warrant dated the 19th Septt 1765 granted to John Elder for 200 acres including his improvement joining lands of Robert Baker, James Ardery and Felix Dayle in Fannet town ship Examined & recalculated from a recent survey, 27 October 1829.
