



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing thirty seven acres fifty seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. which was surveyed by Matthew Henderson formerly D.S. on a warrant granted Alexander Forgey & Andrew Forgey for 50<sup>ths</sup> of land joining their other land in Peters township dated the 26<sup>th</sup> of October 1773 certified the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 1829, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
