



Draught of a tract of land situate in Guilford township Franklin County, containing twenty three acres twenty nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed 2d October 1828, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. and by virtue of a warrant dated 23d December 1766, granted to Adam Hoops for 50 acres "joining his other land on Conococheague Creek in Guilford township."

The above red lined figure marked A. represents a survey which was made the 8th April 1763 for Adam Hoops on a warrant to Robert Craig, bearing date 4th June 1762, and afterwards to wit: on 14th Jan^y 1791, a resurvey was made on the said warrant to Craig, by the then owner - by which resurvey the lines were extended so as to include the land embraced in the above survey & also the dotted figure marked B. amounting to 160^q which survey has been returned to land office.

Note - No evidence of survey on the above warrant to Hoops or of any person claiming under the same. Wm S. Davis.
