


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Southampton township Franklin County containing five acres one hundred & forty eight perches & allowance of six percent for roads &c. Survey'd 17 Sept^{er} 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c, and by virtue of a warrant dated 14 June 1765 granted to William Irwin, for 25 acres "joining his other land in Lorain alias Lurgan township"

Note - The above piece of land was surveyed (with some variation from the above lines) by Matt^w Henderson, formerly D.S. on the 30th August 1794 for which (it was stated) a warrant had been granted to W^m Irwin, for 25 a. dated on or about the 10th of July 1765 query as to a warrant of that date.
