


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Lurgan township Franklin County, containing one hundred & sixty nine acres one hundred & forty seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed 19th September 1829, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly, relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights, and by virtue of a warrant dated 20th February 1754 granted to Archibald Mahan for 100⁰ joining Abraham Weere and William Woods on the North side of Conedoguinet Creek in Lurgan township.

Report.

The above tract is covered by a survey of 304 9. 151 P^E & allowance on a warrant to Archibald Mahan dated 29 August 1785. Note - Although the warrant of 1754 calls for 100 acres yet the relative situation of the boundaries & improvement would necessarily include more land, the blank dotted figure represents the balance of survey on the warrant of 1785. Owners, John, David & George Maxwell part James Herrans Heirs - Catherine Rohm, Jacob Hartman occupant under Herrans Heirs.
