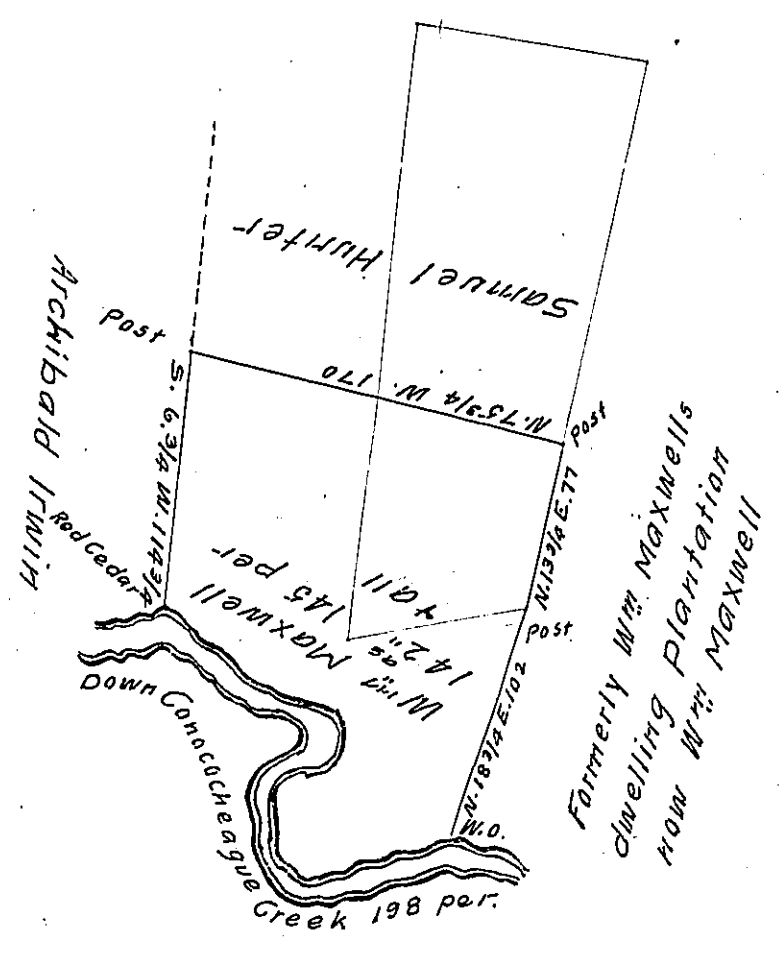

Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing one hundred & forty two acres one hundred & forty five perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c located the 28th of March 1828 (on warrant granted William Maxwell for 100 a^s of land on Conacocheague Creek joining his dwelling plantation & Hugh Shannon, in Peters township dated the 20th of November 1753) in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
