



Application 4080-30th June 1767 to Joseph Walker for 50^{ac} in Tyrone TOWNSHIP

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed application granted 30th June 1767- No 4080 to Joseph Walker for 50^{ac} in Tyrone township, on lands situate as aforesaid and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram- Witness my hand-
