



The Part marked **A** is an interference of a Tract of 117<sup>ac</sup> 83<sup>rs</sup> and allow<sup>se</sup> being part of 231 acres of which Patrick Gallagher Died possessed, his executors sold said 117<sup>ac</sup> 83<sup>rs</sup> to John Gallaher by deed dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 1808, and who sold the same by Deed of same date to Jacob Adams, whose Ex<sup>t</sup> sold the same to Joseph Sneeringer who now owns and claims the same —

The part marked **B** is an interference of 32<sup>ac</sup> 117 perches, which Bernard Winters and wife (heirs of P. Gallaher) sold to Joseph Shultz by Deed dated 29<sup>th</sup> March 1811, who sold the same to Jacob Adams, whose Ex<sup>t</sup> sold to Joseph Sneeringer sen<sup>r</sup> who now owns and claims the same — Being part in Berwick & part in Mt Pleasant Townships —
