



The above represents a tract of Land Situate in Washington Township Franklin (late Antrim Township Cumberland) County, which was originally surveyed for Archibald Beard the 28th day of May (obl.) 1764 in pursuance of the Honourable the proprietaries Warrant dated October the 6th 1762 Resurveyed for Samuel Hughes Junr January 3rd 1811 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of property Dated November 6th 1810, agreeable to the lines of the Original Survey, correcting sundry errors in the return of said Survey except to include a small vacancy (agreeable to said order) which appears to be clear of any other claim and within the possession of said Hughes Containing in the whole Seventy three acres and One hundred and six perches and the usual allowance of six p. Cent. for roads &c.

N.B. Part of the above is claimed by John Toms on a subsequent Survey made in pursuance of a warrant granted to Hans Snowbarger Dated Sept^r 8th 1755
