of Land Situate in Huntington  
Township in the County of York Resurveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1797 by  
the lines formerly run in Pursuance of a Warrant to to William Beals  
Dated the 24<sup>th</sup> June 1763 Containing in the whole one Hundred &  
Thirty one Acres and one Hundred perches & allowance of Six Acres  
& Cent for Roads &c. N.B. That part where the letter A is placed  
Contains one Hundred and Twenty Six Acres & 100 perches & allowance,  
and the part where the letter B is placed Contains five Acres & allow-  
ance this was sold off of the whole Tract for the Ground of a Meeting  
house for the Quaker Society
