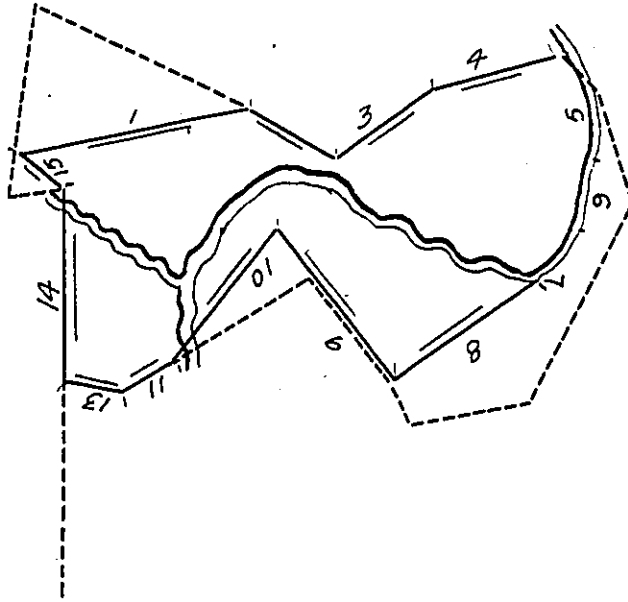

A Draft of a tract of land situate in the main forks of Conoloway Creeks in Bethel Township, Bedford County, containing One hundred & thirty Three Acres & Eighty three perches & allowance of six per cent. for roads & so, Surveyed for Joseph Warford the 12th day of December 1787 on Order N^o 1935 dated the 24th day of November 1766.

The dotted lines represent a draft of a tract of land Surveyed for Joseph Warford the 23rd day of August 1805 on a warrant dated the 18th day of May 1763. - This survey interferes One Hundred & thirty three Acres & Eighty three perches with the Joseph Warford tract - Joseph Warford conveyed to Jacob Bishop & William Powell. Jacob Bishop devised his part to William Bishop, the present owner. - William Powel conveyed to Powel Vanderve the present owner.
