



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1833 by virtue of an Order<sup>or warrant</sup> granted to Samuel Rhoads Jr. dated the 14<sup>th</sup> February 1771 containing two hundred and seventy nine acres with the usual Allowance of six pr. Cent. & c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> of June 1771 for David Davis in pursuance of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1239 And now owned and occupied by John Hoy in right of the said David Davis
