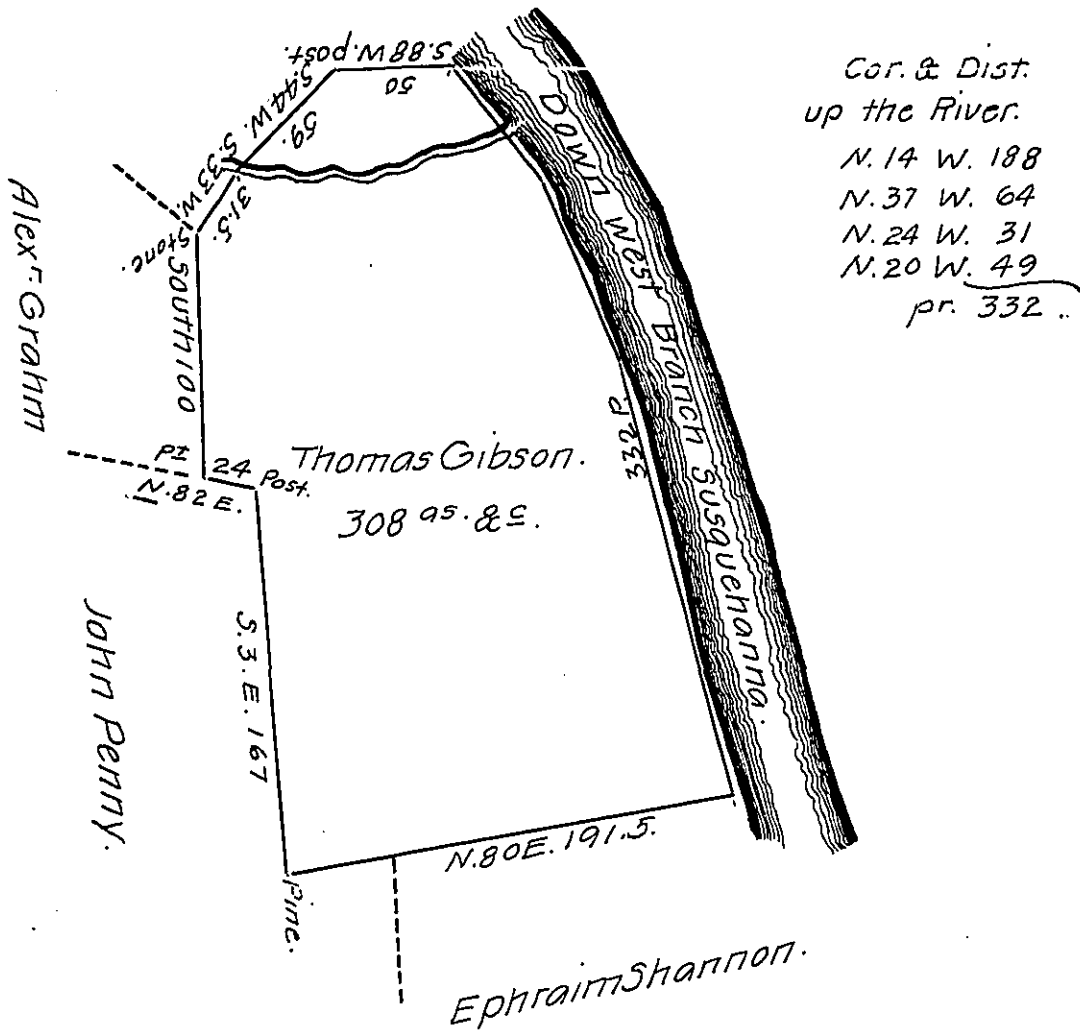


Late Tho. Lemmon.
