From the lines on the ground it appears that a  
 Present owners, Survey was made sometime in the year 1768 or 69. No  
 Robinson & Co. Draught to shew the date of the Survey. the improvmt.  
 who occupy the same on it was commenced sometime about the year 1814 — this  
 Actual Survey tract is covered by a Survey under a Warrant, <sup>dated 12<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1802</sup> Since 1800:  
 Rees Pat. which was Patented to Lewis Rees. the present Survey  
contains together 333 A 10 1/4 P & allow. but Lewis Rees's

Survey as returned & Patented is somewhat more.
