From the line trees in the above Survey, it appears that the Survey was made in 1768 or 69 — No Draught to shew the date of the Survey — a Warrant was granted to Samuel Potts dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1787 on which a Survey for 186 A 43 E & allow. was made & Returned — and afterwards patented. The improvements on it are a house, barn & other buildings and about 50 A of cleared land. commenced about 23 years ago.
