



Situate in Conewago (late Newberry) township in the County of York Containing within the black lines 62 a 90 perches & allowance &c. Surveyed on the 18th day of May 1831. In persuance of a warrant granted to William Legget for 70 as dated the 4th day of October 1770 and by Virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report Owned and Occupied by Jacob Westhaffer and included in a resurvey of 183 a 155 ps &c. made on the 5 day of September 1791 in persuance of a warrant granted to Robert Hodgen dated the 14th of November 1741.

It is not known by the neighbors that - Legget was ever in possession. The dotted lines represent the balance of - Hodgens survey to the Board of Property
