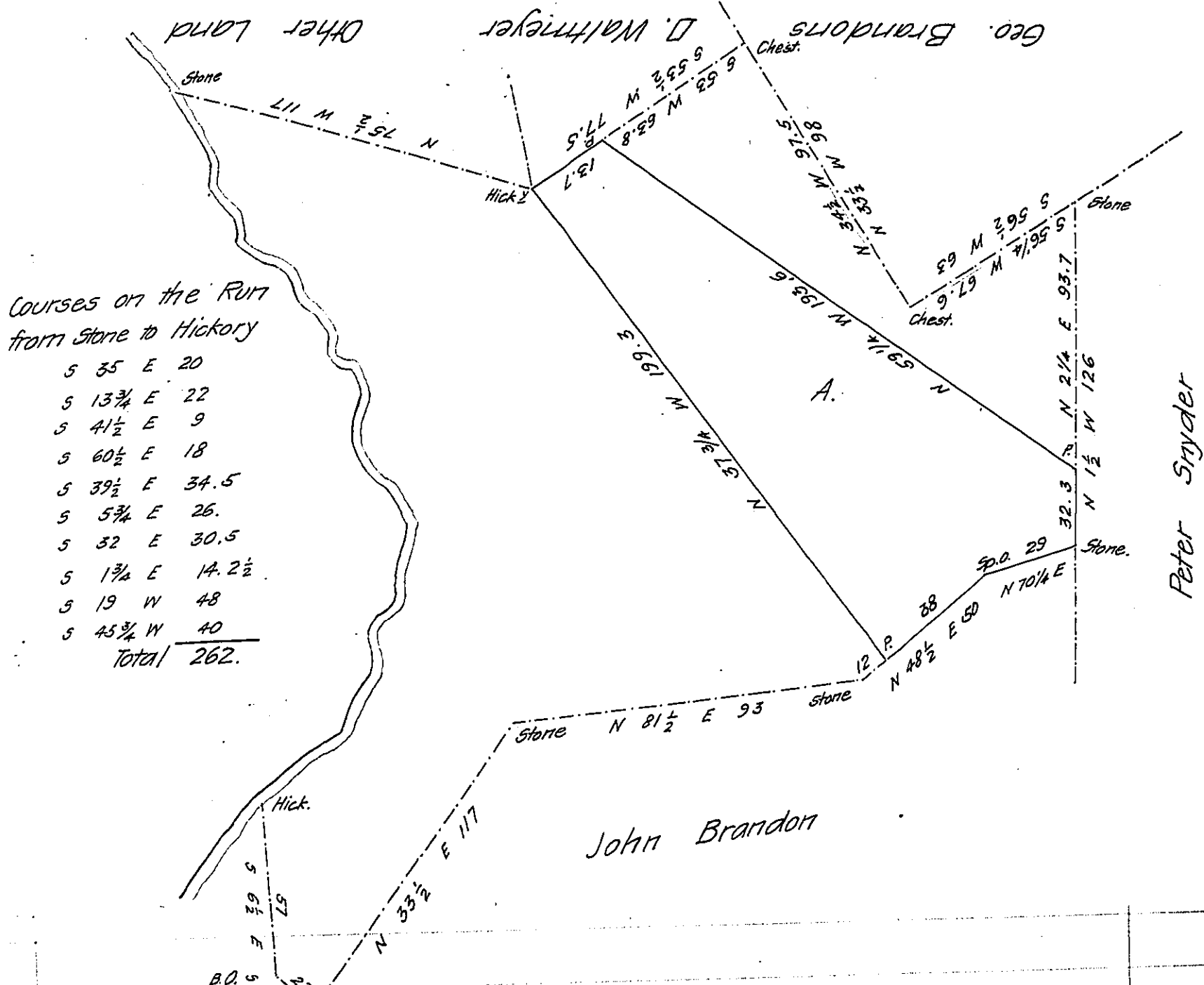

Warrant 18th October 1753 to John Smith for 50^{as} between Geo Brandon and the Pine Hills in Huntingdon Township.

The Part marked A is an Interference of a larger Tract of 233^{as} 98 ps and all^{ce} surveyed on 2 warrants to George Brandon, the one in his own name dated 18th Oct^r 1753 the other in the name of Geo. Stevenson and George Smith date not known situate in Huntingdon Township Adams County Now owned by Templeton Brandon & others. Witness my hand
