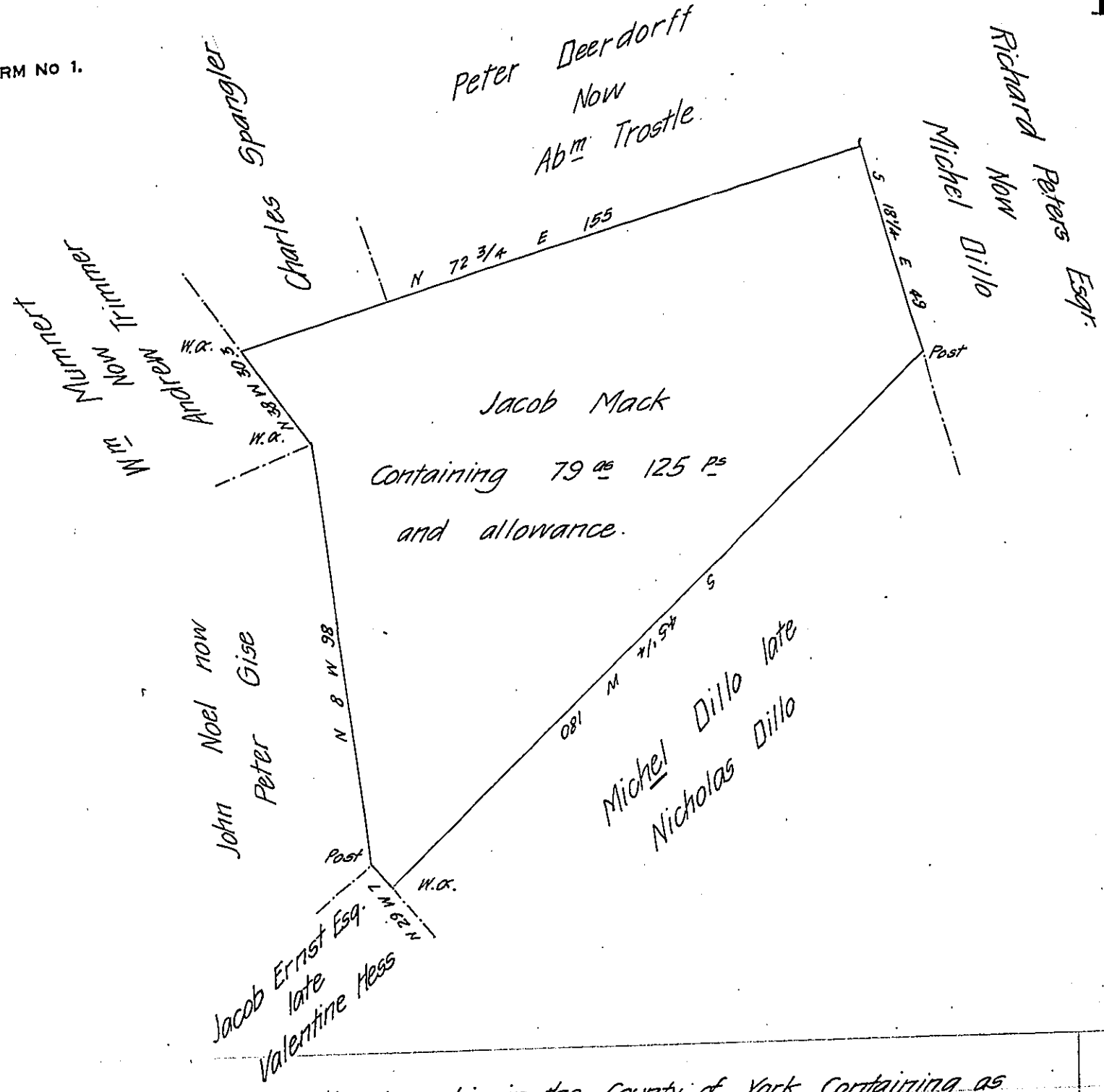


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Paradise township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 79 ac 125 ps & the usual allowance. Surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Mack for 100 ac dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1765 and in pursuance of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report - This land was also surveyed and returned on two warrants one granted to Gottlieb Briecher dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 1755 and the other to a certain John Groaf dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of April 1765. Now owned & occupied by Peter Gise. No evidence of Mack ever being in possession.
