 to George Black for 100<sup>as</sup>  
 in Mt pleasant Township  
 Interference.

The whole of the above tract is an Interference of a Tract of 153<sup>as</sup>  
 & 111. p<sup>s</sup> Surveyed April 9<sup>th</sup> 1836 by Isaac Robinson D. Sr. in pursuance of  
 a Warrant granted to Francis Leas for 150<sup>as</sup> dated March 24<sup>th</sup> 1836  
 now owned and occupied by said Francis Leas, and at this date unpat-  
 ented - situate in Mountpleasant Township Adams County.
