



Situate in Lower Chanceford township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 56<sup>ac</sup> 64<sup>ps</sup> and the usual allowance Surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Dougherty for 60<sup>ac</sup> dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1774 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report - This Land is now owned and occupied by William & Levi Kilgore and is the same as was Surveyed and Returned in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Morrison for 50<sup>ac</sup> dated 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1751. No evidence of Dougherty ever being in possession.
