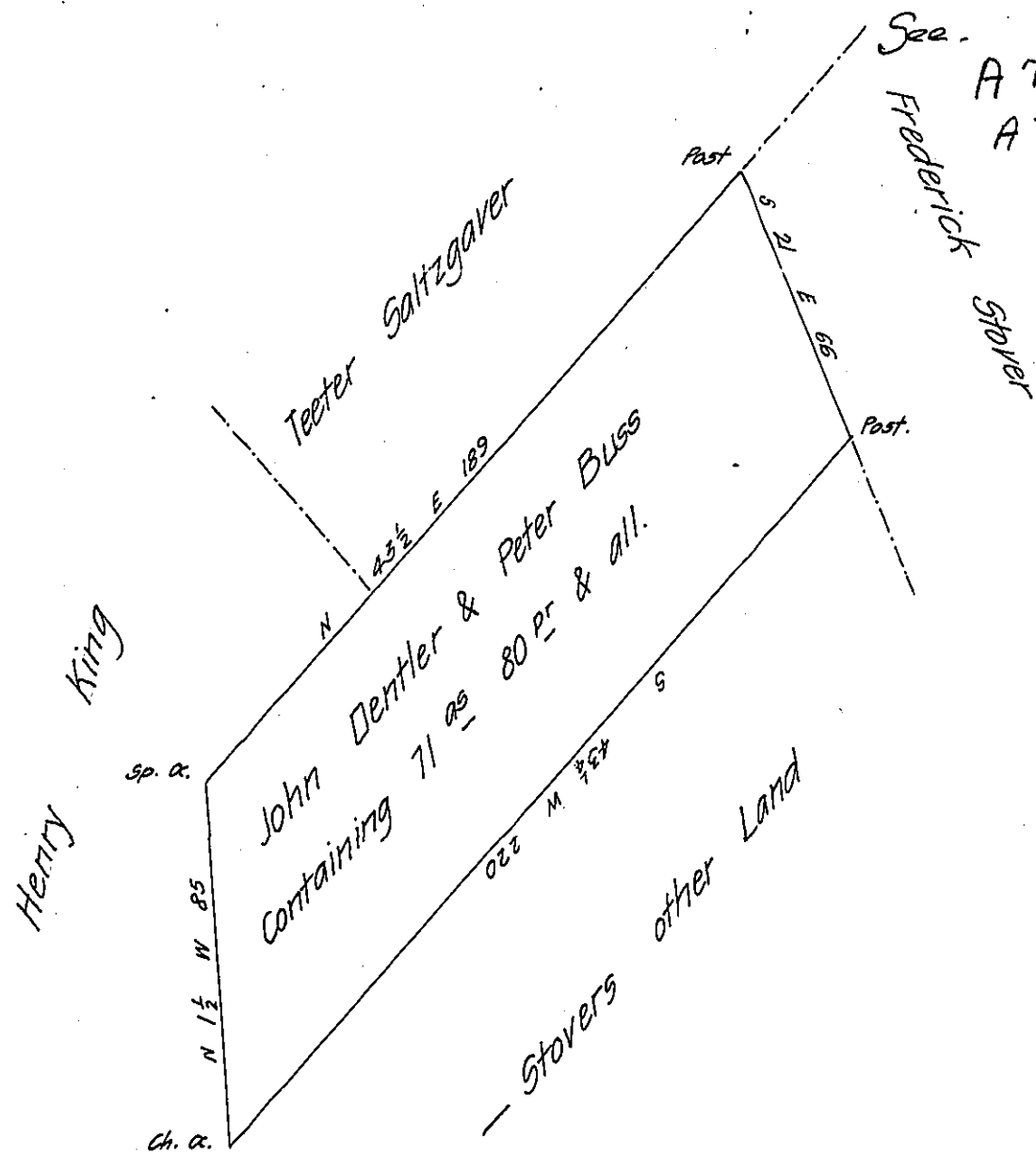

Located on the 10th day of September 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Dentler & Peter Buss for 50^{ac} dated 30th of November 1769 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report - This Land is now owned and occupied by Michel Stover and was Patented to his Father Frederick Stover on the 13th of April 1771 on two warrants granted to Tho^s Armor - one for 25^{ac} dated 19 May 1752 and the other for 40^{ac} dated the 4th April 1754
