



In pursuance of the Several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant issued 18th October 1753 to John Neily for 20 acres joining his other Land, on Lands situate in Reading Township Adams County adjoining Lands of John Neily and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
