

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 25th day of the 1st month 1701. I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed and laid out unto Randal Croxton Heir of Randal Croxton deceased purchaser of two hundred and fifty acres a certain tract of Land scituate on the South side of Brandywine Creek in the County of Chester containing one hundred acres being the remainder of his Father's said purchase beginning at a Corner post of Bartholomew Coppock's Land from thence North four hundred perches to a Corner black oak from thence West forty perches to a corner Gum tree from thence South four hundred perches to a Corner post standing by the Street or Road, from thence East forty perches to the first mentioned Corner post Surveyed the 9th day of the 2^d month 1701 and returned according to the abovesaid survey and Bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 17th day of the 5th month 1701
