



Warr^t granted 2^d March 1772 to James Semple for 100^{as} in the South Mountain in Huntingdon T.

The Part marked A is an Interference of a tract of 54^{as} 156^{ps} & all^{ce} surveyed on warr^t to Andrew Ramsey dated June 1st 1762 - Situate in Huntingdon Township Adams County now owned by Ludwick Waltemeyer

The Part marked B is an Intf^{ce} of a tract of 43^{as} 33^{ps} & all^{ce} surveyed on warr^t to John Moorhead dated October 12th 1814. Situate in Huntingdon T. now owned by W^m Moorhead. The triangle C. appears to be Vacant - Witness my hand
