Then Surveyed for Joseph Bushell 140 acres of Land near Concord. begining a(obl) a marked red oak being the marked corner tree of robert piles and runing along the 5d piles 1(obl) of marked trees 548 degrees w 320 perch to a marked white oak then S.E. 80 perch to a(obl) white oak then N.E. 320 perch to a marked red oak and from thence N.W. 60 perch to the first mentioned red oak.
