
William Penn, Proprietary & Govern^t of ye Province of Pennsilvania &

At ye Request of Samuel Barker, y^t I would grant him to take up
Five hundred Acres of Land purchased in ye Province of Penns-
ylvania. These are to will & require thee forthwith to Survey or cause
to be survey'd unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye County of Ches-
ter in any Township not yet layd out next to ye City of Philadelphia,
and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at
Philadelphia ye 6th 8b^r 1683.
