These are therefore in ye Proprietarys Name to will & require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto him the said Number of Acres in ye aforesaid County, where not already taken up, according to ye Method of Townshipp^s, appointed by ye Govern^r. he seating & Improving the same within Six Months from ye date of Survey, and make returns thereof into ye Govern^r's Secretary's Office.
