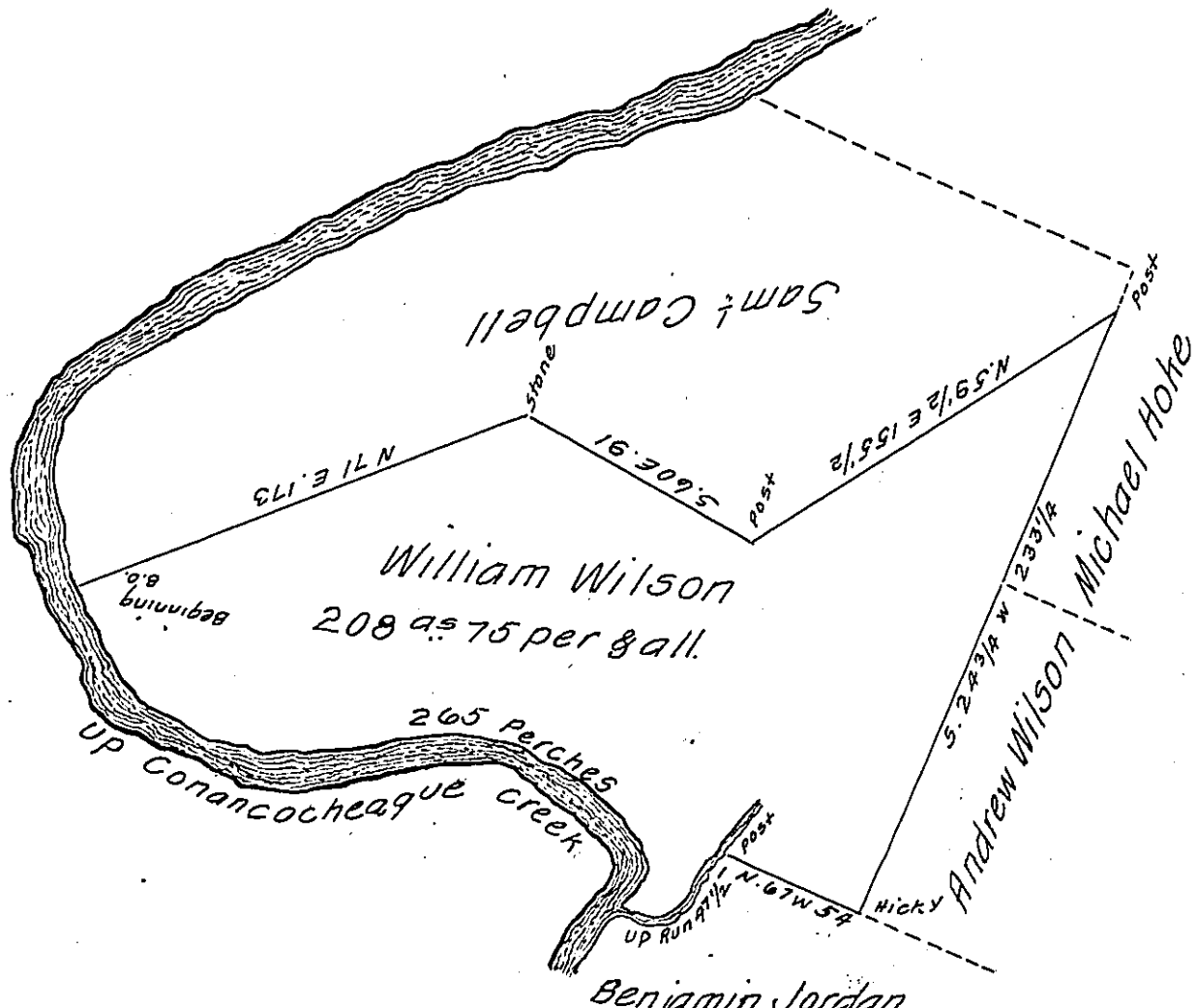

Seventy five perches & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 24th of December 1828. agreeable to line run for John Wilson by Thomas Cook son. formerly Deputy Surveyor (on a Warrant granted William Wilson for 190⁹ of land in Rathmullen Township - Note said to have been first Surveyed to John Wilson on Warrant of 14th July 1744. dated the 6th of May 1749) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary Rights &c.
