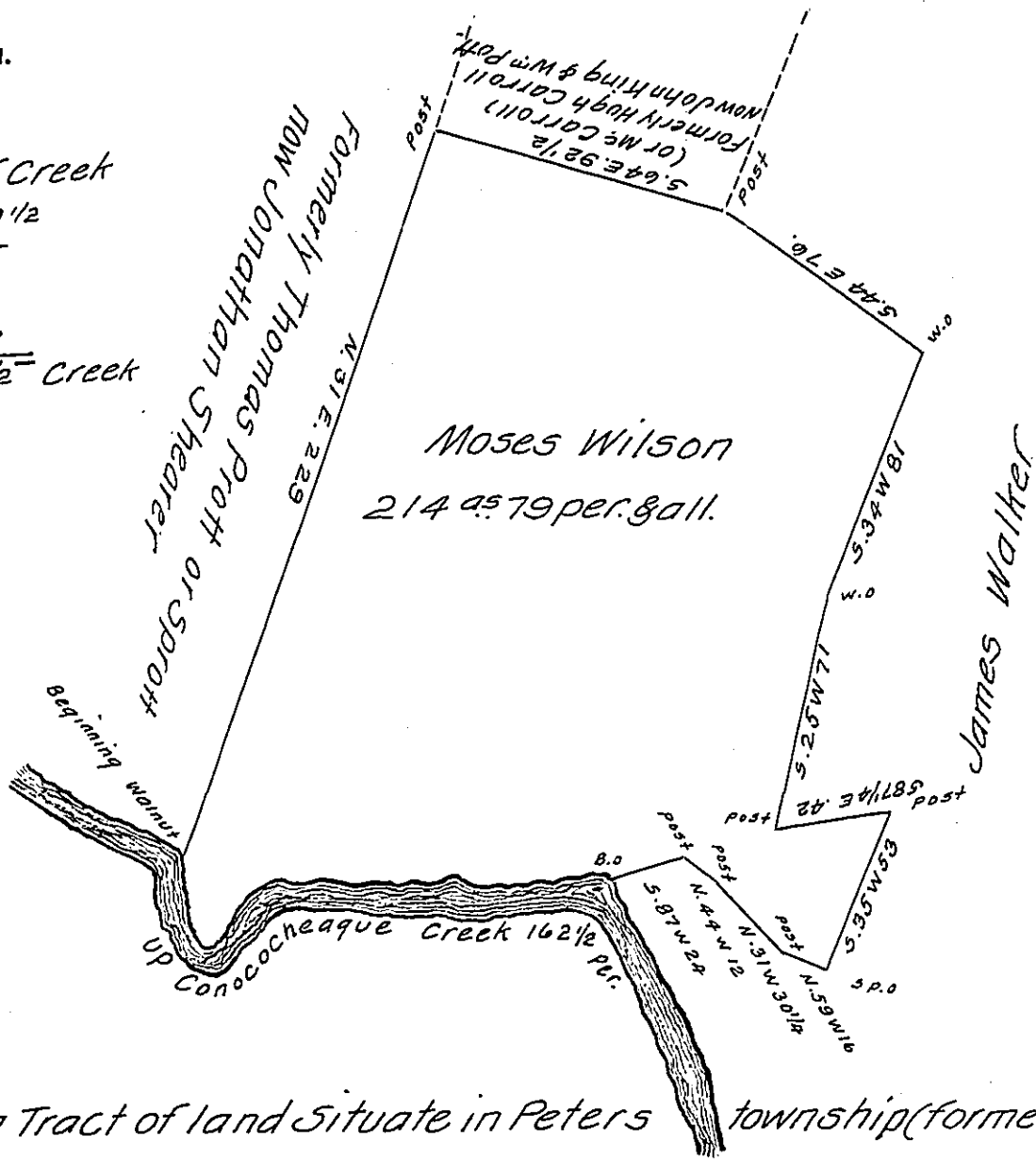

Draft of a Tract of land situate in Peters township (formerly Hopewell township) Franklin County. Containing Two Hundred & fourteen acres. Seventy nine perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 22nd of August 1829 (agreeable to lines formerly run by Matthew Henderson formerly D.S. on a Warrant granted Moses Wilson for 300^{ac} of land on Conococheague Creek joining Tho^s Pratt & Hugh Carroll in Hopewell township dated the 2nd of March 1737) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly Relating to proprietary Rights &c.
