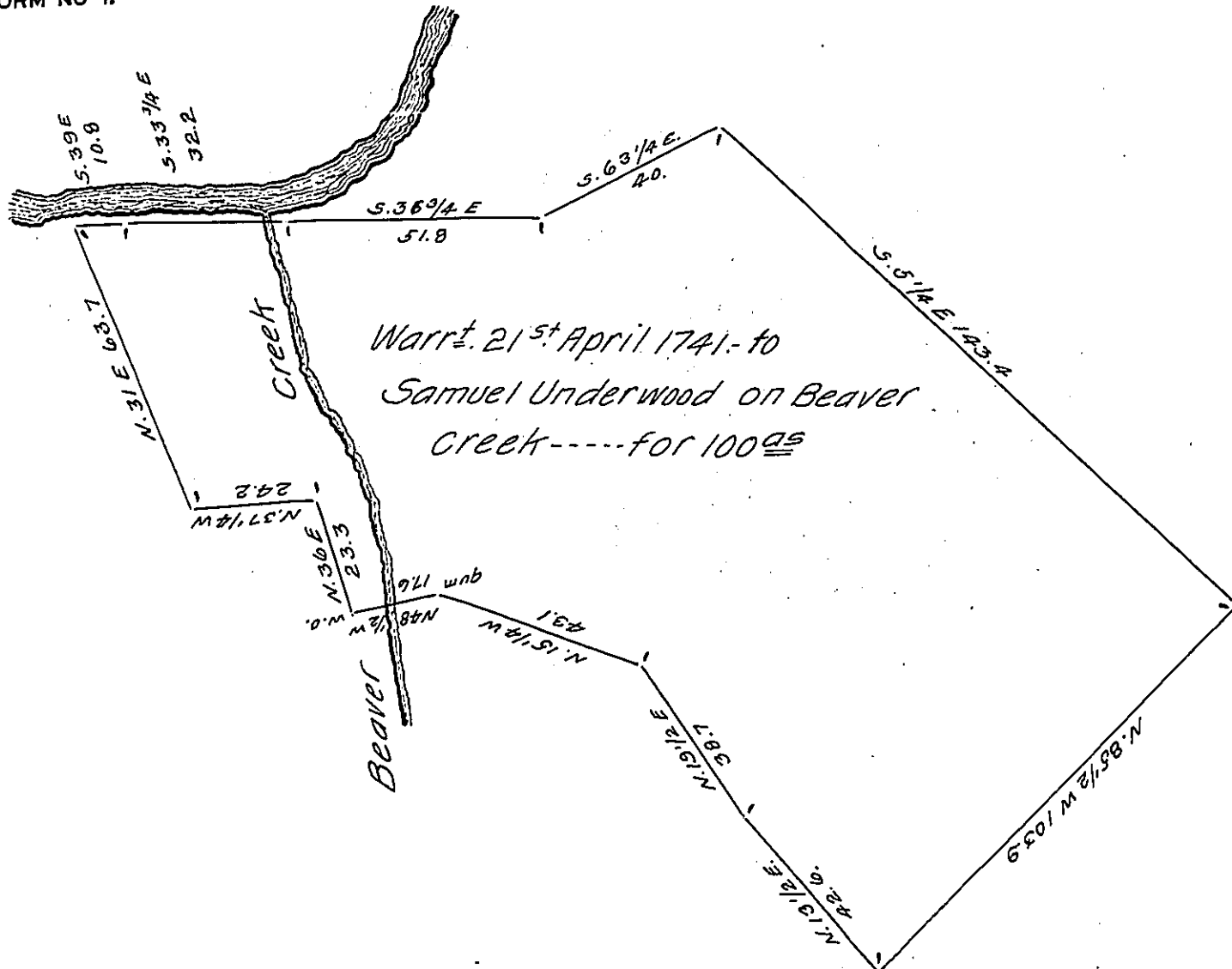

Warrt. 21st April 1741. to Samuel Underwood on Beaver Creek-----for 100^{acs}

Joining the North West side of a Settlement which W^m. Griffith hath made.

In pursuance of the Several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes. I have this day located & Surveyed Warrant granted 21st April 1741 to Samuel Underwood on Beaver Creek - for 100 acres, on Lands situate on Beaver Creek Joining the N.W. side of a Settlement which W^m Griffith hath made, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. — Witness my hand
