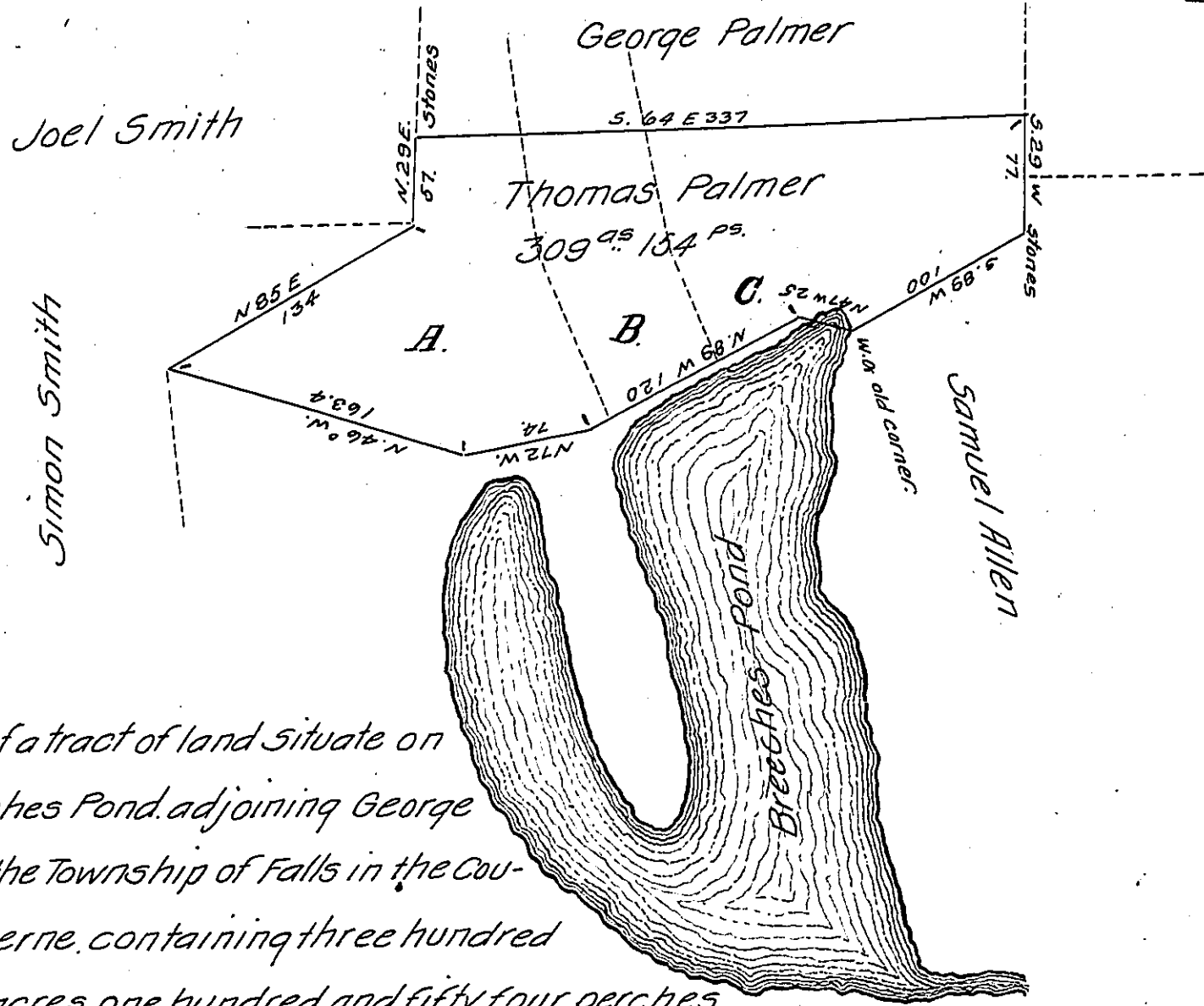


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate on the Breeches Pond adjoining George Palmer, in the Township of Falls in the County of Luzerne, containing three hundred and Nine acres, one hundred and fifty four perches of land, besides the usual allow^g. &c. Surveyed in 1774 as appears by blocking the trees upon the ground. Resurveyed the above described tract of land for Thomas Palmer the 11th day of April 1828 by Virtue of his Warrant dated the 6th day of August 1773, and in pursuance of instructions from the Board of Property under an Act of Assembly of the 22nd March 1820. And its Supplement of the 11th April 1825.
