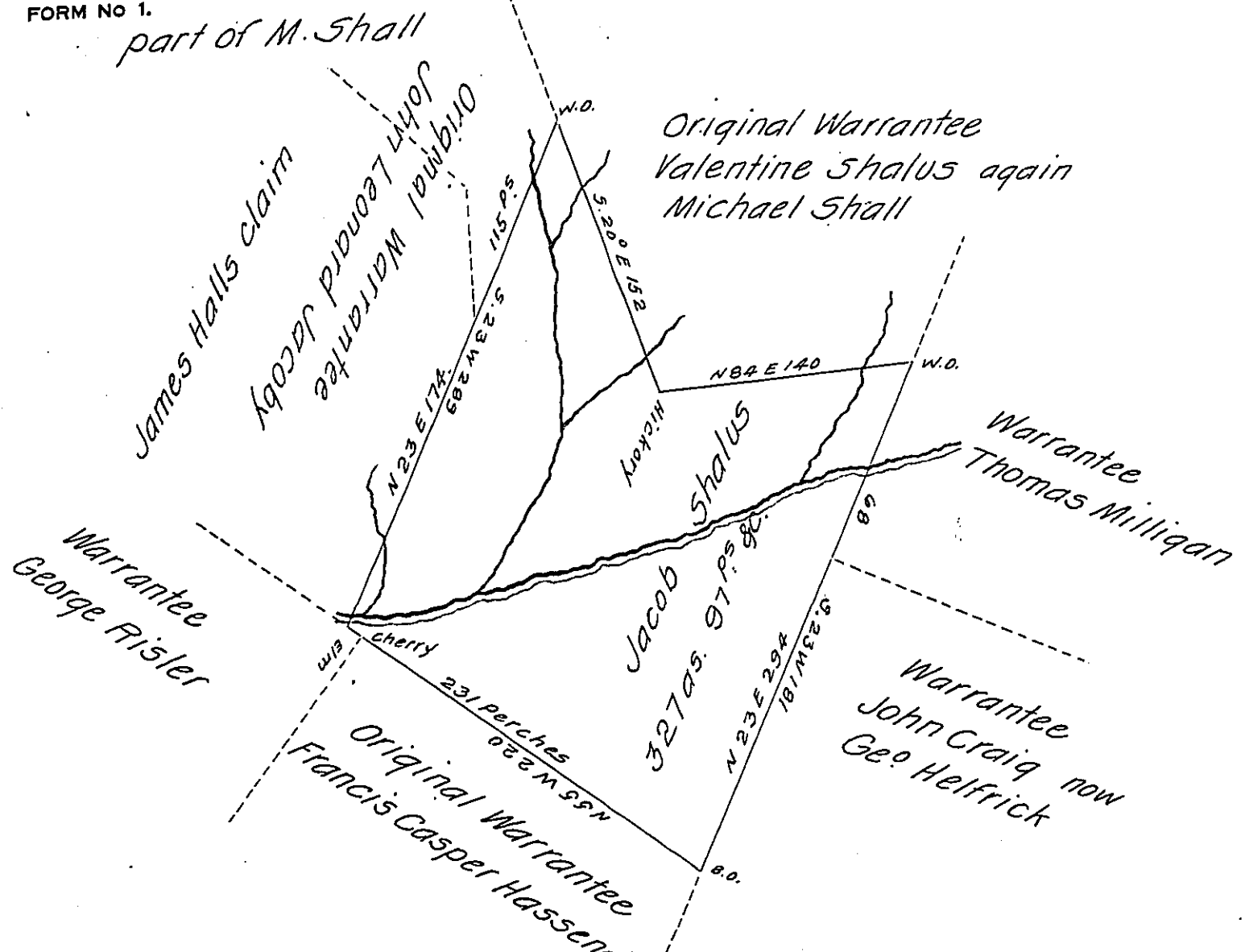

In pursuance of a Contract made with ~~the~~ the Board of Property dated the 19th of October 1827. I have examined the situation and boundaries of the above described tract of land and agreeable to the papers in this Office it appears to be the same tract of land which was first surveyed to Jacob Shalus on the 24th of Sept: 1776 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the same dated the 7th of March 1775 and by endorsement on the back of the same is one of the Surveys of J. Vandever. which contains three hundred and twenty seven acres ninety seven perches and the Allowance of Six P. C^t 8c. Situate in Kittanning township Armstrong County. bounded as represented by the Diagram. But the same was afterwards surveyed to James Elder on the 3^d of Dec: 1788. by Warrant of the 8th of October 1788 and is in possession of tenants and Owners who claim under the letter title.
