



Warrt 28th Decem^r 1744. - to Hugh Whiteford for 25^{ac} on the Temporary Line.

The above Tract is an Interference of a Large Tract of Land taken up by Charles Carroll under Maryland, Called Carrollsburg (the Lower Tract) and which he Conveyed the 6th May 1757 to William Cochran, under whom it is now held by James & Henry Mc Divitt, situate now in Liberty Township Adams County - Witness my hand.
