



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Washington Township in the County of York on the first fork of the Bermudian— about four Miles from the Great Conewago— Containing as above set forth 196 1/2 a. Surveyed on the 26th day of November A.D. 1832. in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Peter Shultz Dated the 19th day of October 1738 &c. the above Land is now held by David Herman, which was Surveyed for Martin Weybright in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19th day of October 1738. then Resurveyed on the 2nd day of June 1762 to Adam Herman and John Mundorff in Pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey dated the 30th day May 1761. and Returned in the Sec.^y office the 17th June 1773. Called the favourite and Patented by Thomas Penn and John Penn to Adam Herman a patent dated the 17th June 1773.
