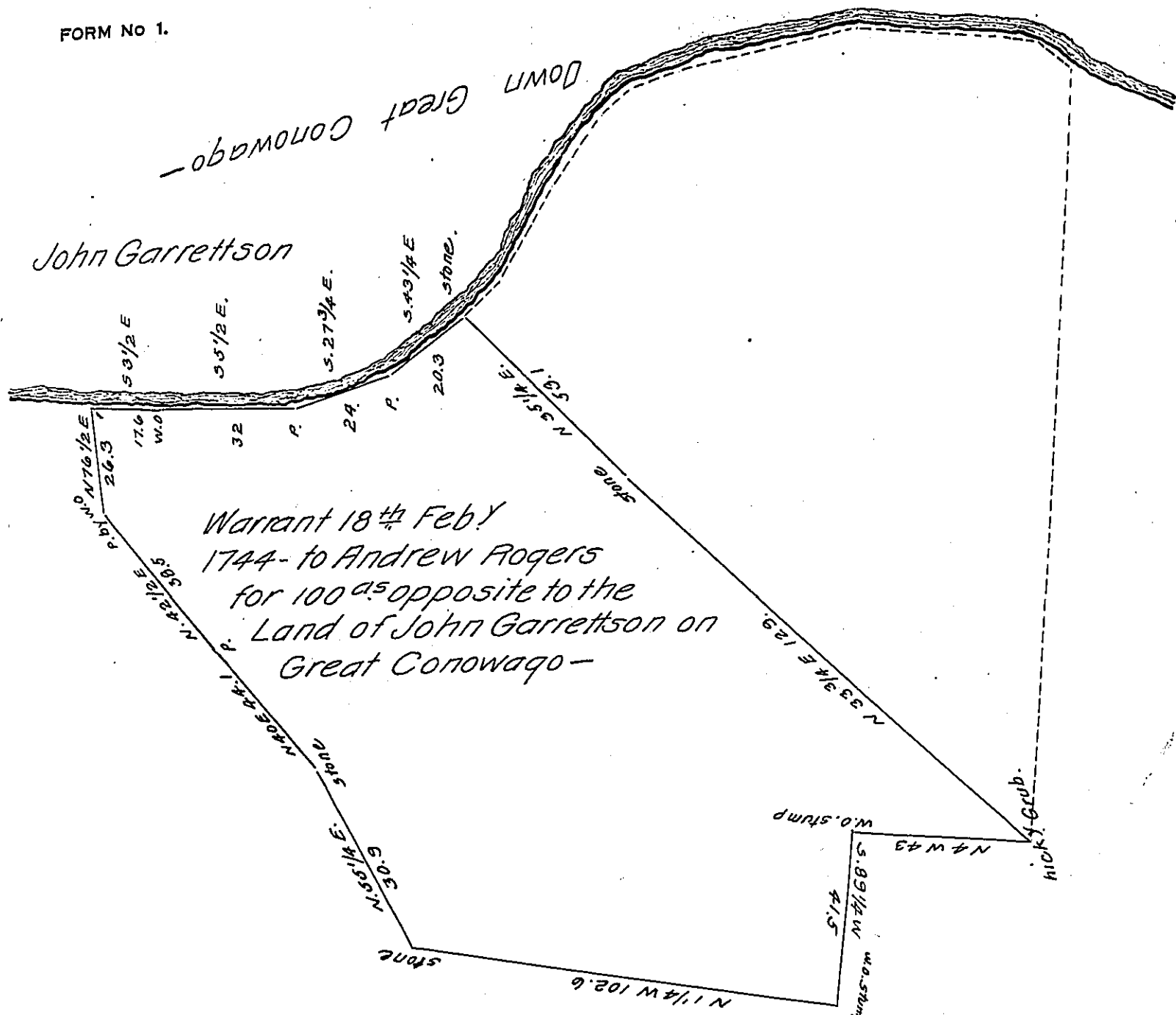

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 18th February 1744- to Andrew Rogers for 100^{ac} as above Specified, on Lands situate as afore said, and have found the Interferences as Represented in the enclosed Diagram-
