



Situate in Buffaloe township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 18th day of August 1769 for Robert Fulton by virtue of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 2463. Containing One hundred and Ninety three Acres with the usual Allowance of Six Br. Cent &c. As Appears from the field and table works of William Maclay then Deputy Surveyor. Resurveyed the 16th day of October 1832 and found Correct.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 7th day of April 1786 for James Thome in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 14th day of December 1785 - And now owned & Occupied by Jacob Housel and Henry Jordan in right of the said James Thome -
