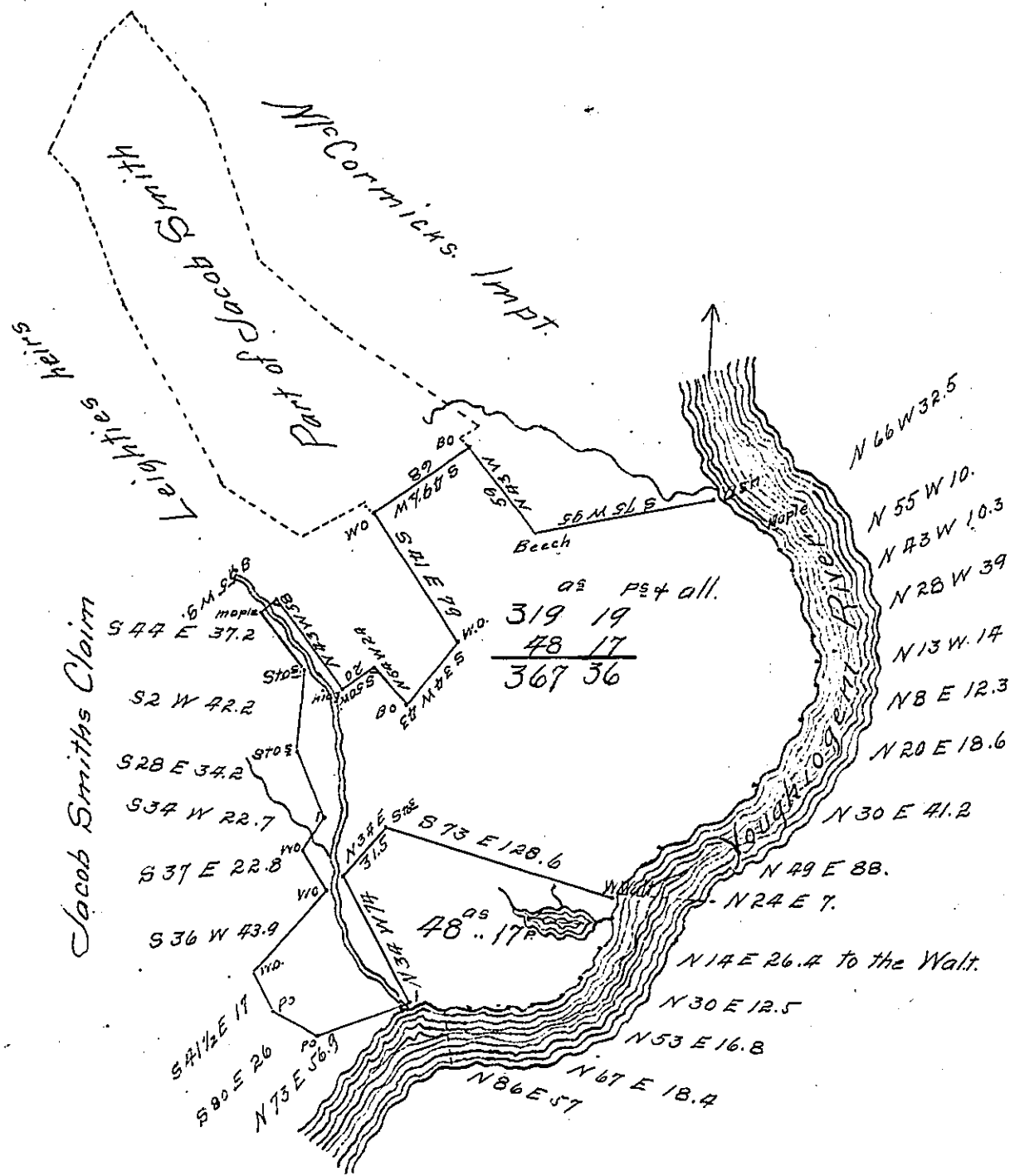

The land is claimed or owned by William W. Taylor of Baltimore Md. Merchant.
