Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1837 by Virtue of an Order granted to John Wallace dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2513. Containing two Hundred & Seventy three Acres & one Hundred perches & the Usual Allowance &c. Note. The Same tract of land was Surveyed for John Moore the 9<sup>th</sup> August 1769. In pursuance of his order Dated 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769. & now owned by the Heirs of Thomas Wilson. Dec<sup>d</sup> in right of the said John Moore.
