



The above N°1 was surveyed and returned on a Warrant granted to William Anderson dated July 23^d 1784 - patentend.

N°2 was returned on an Application granted to Charles M'Coy. N°-1 is erased on the patent being in the fold &c patented to Philip Smith - the dotted line represents the ground enclosed by the Survey. This land was never in posession of M'creery though this is the land he Applied for.
